

## Thammasat University Notification Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19)(NO, 26)

Pursuant to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 25, upon monitoring the current situation of the spread, and following the announcement of the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA), it appears that the daily number of newly infected cases and accumulated infected cases have continued to increase and spread across the country. With concern for the health, and for the purpose of prevention and risk reduction of infection among university personnel and students having to travel, to work, or to participate in a variety of activities,

To respond to these incidents, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures:

- 1. Extending the work-from-home policy to 4 July 2021 in compliance with Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No 22, Item 1.
- 2. All academic and supporting staff and students shall strictly follow and comply with the measures issued by the Thai government as well as the local authorities.
