

## Thammasat University Notification

on

## Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) (NO. 38)

With reference to Thammasat University Notification on Measures and Recommendations on the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus (COVID-19) No. 37, promulgating additional regulations and measures for government units, due to an improving Covid-19 situation and further easing of the nationwide Covid-19 control measures by the Royal Thai Government,

In order to maintain the efficient operations of the university, Thammasat University hereby issues the following measures:

- 1. The previous Thammasat University Notification (No.37) shall no longer apply and is hereby replaced by this present notification (No.38).
- 2. University staff will return to work on campus unless it is necessary to prevent the spread of Covid-19 in their work units. The responsible Vice Rector and unit heads may implement alternative work schedules, requests to refrain from working, staggering working hours, and/or adjusting shift rotations and work rotation, subject to the nature of work and the need for work continuity.
- 3. Teaching and assessment of student learning shall continue to be conducted in accordance with Thammasat University Notification on Guidelines for Semester 2/2021, dated 12 November 2021 until further notice.
- 4. The Vice Rector in charge and heads of units must strictly, continually and consistently control, observe and monitor the implementation of preventive measures against the spread of COVID-19 as well as take precautionary measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- 5. All academic and support staff and students must strictly follow and comply with the measures issued by the Thai government, local authorities as well as notifications issued by the university and their work unit.

Effective from 1 June 2022 onwards.
